Mozart's masterpiece, the Divertimento for string trio in E flat major, was written around the same time as the famous song, "Sehnsucht nach dem Frühlinge" ("Yearning for the Springtime"). It is perhaps not surprising then to find a portion of the melody from this song in the 6<sup>th</sup> Movement of the Trio. This and other magical melodies by Mozart, Hindemith and Debussy offer a delightful listening experience, and not just in the springtime! Between the musical works, the musicians will offer short explanations to the pieces and their composers.
